SUBJ: 2009-2010 Fall/Winter Swim Team PAYMENT OPTIONS

For the Fall/Winter Swim Team, you have the following payment options for paying your child(ren)'s Swim Team Fees:

Option I

Payment in full upon registration.

Option II

Authorize the YMCA to automatically charge your Visa / MasterCard or American Express OR automatic bank drafts. By completing the attached form, you will be authorizing the YMCA to automatically charge your credit card or draft your bank account on or about the 5th of October, November and December according to the chart below. (Fees must be paid in accordance to the timeline noted below.)

PLEASE NOTE:

Fees must be paid using one of the above two options. The **ONLY** way to pay in payments is to have the fees automatically charged or drafted. If choosing to use the payment options, the following due dates are followed:

- 25% of fees are due immediately upon registration
 - 50% of fees are due October 5
 - 75% of fees are due November 5
 - 100% of fees are due December 5
- ❖ If you register after October 5, expect to pay 50% of the fees at that time. The remaining balance may be split into two payments. November 5 & December 5 according to fee schedule above.
- ❖ All Swim Team participants **MUST** possess a YMCA Membership valid through the season. Membership information is available at the YMCA.
